



### Linking Institutional Policies to Student Success (LIPSS-Pilot): Fast Facts #3

On the whole, institutions are giving their students a lot of information. But look at the way schools share info *after* classes begin...

There's a real drop off in information sharing after classes begin. Fewer than half of participating schools remind students about "social behavior codes/standards" or "expectations regarding academic efforts" or who to contact regarding academic difficulties after the school year has actually started... the precise time when first-year students are confronting their first bad grades, their first social decisions, and their first bouts of homesickness.
